If you watched *The Linda McCartney Story* on TV or saw the trailer for *Heartbreakers*, then you've already heard **The Fab Four**... and just didn't know it. Their precise attention to detail elevates The Fab Four above every other Beatles tribute. With uncanny, note-perfect renditions of Beatles' songs, they will make you think you're watching the real thing. With good reason, the *Los Angeles Times* has called them "The best Beatles show in the world!" This is their first appearance at *Arizona Musicfest*.

Both fans and critics agree that **Ardy Sarraf** is the best musician ever to portray **Paul McCartney**. Ardy has toured extensively as Paul, including Japan, Korea, Guam and Puerto Rico, to name a few. He has also performed with major artists, including Bruce Springsteen, Micky Dolenz and John Fogerty.

Ardy's left-handed bass playing and "record accurate" vocals have won him first place in numerous Beatlefest sound-alike contests. In addition, he plays piano for *Hey Jude* and *Let It Be*, just as McCartney did on the original recordings.

Ron McNeil has performed as **John Lennon** in concerts around the world including Japan, Hong Kong, Argentina, and Brazil (for an audience of 30,000!). In Malaysia, he played in a special performance for the Prime Minister. He was also chosen to perform in numerous shows promoting the Turner Home Entertainment video *The Beatles Anthology*.

Ron's incredible look and sound-alike abilities have created the ultimate loving tribute to the incomparable John Lennon. Each night, Ron's uncanny rendition of *Imagine* captures the spirit of the man fans knew and loved.

Born and raised in Liverpool, the birthplace of The Beatles, and bearing a remarkable resemblance to **George Harrison**, it seems inevitable that **Gavin Pring** would find his way into in the cast of The Fab Four.

Gavin's natural Liverpudlian wit and charm have won him acclaim around the world; he is now one of the most sought-after artists in his field. He has performed in a number of international venues and has even shared the stage with Sir Paul McCartney himself. Gavin's attention to detail makes him the best tribute to the "quiet Beatle."

Rolo Sandoval began portraying **Ringo Starr** when he was 19 years old. Known as the most solid drummer in the Beatle business, he has played internationally with the groups Beatlemania, Twist and Shout, Revolver, and Classical Mystery Tour. His true musical home, however, lies with The Fab Four, where his limitless talent enables him to duplicate Ringo's trademark sound, on drums and vocals.

For over 30 years, **Jerry Hoban** has performed his renowned **Ed Sullivan** impersonation, sharing the stage with such stars as Paul Revere & The Raiders, Peter Noone of *Herman's Hermits* and Freddy "Boom Boom" Cannon. He appeared in Quentin Tarantino's *Pulp Fiction*, and has been featured in TV shows, including *Growing Pains* with Kirk Cameron, *Dark Skies* with Eric Close and *Magnum, P.I.* with Tom Selleck. More recently, he appeared with Ellen DeGeneres on *Ellen's Really Big Show*.
